Competition Program:

Road Race 1 hour + 1 lap on Sunday 18. October 2015

Start time all classes: 13:00

The race track is closed for other traffic between 12:30 and 14:30.

Road race on a flat 4K Circuit / 19m in altidude per lap

Divisions will start block by block. The race is finished for all classes, as soon as the fastest rider on the race track has passed the finish line after 1 hour + 1 lap.

Registration and entry fee:

The deadline for the EHC Final at Lengau is on 4. October 2015. Late registration after this date won't be possible due to organizational reasons.

The entry fee is 45,00 Euros and must be paid until 4. October 2015. If you pay later or on the race venue the entry fee is 55,00 Euros.

Please prepare also 20,00 Euros for the chip deposit only to be paid on location.

Where do I get the start numbers?

The start numbers and chips will be distributed on Sunday 18. October at the Palfinger Factory from 11:00 until 12:30

Warm Up:

On closed race track from 12:30 until 13:00

Regulations:

The EHC event will be run under EHF regulations.

Medical Assistance:

Red Cross medical assistance in the start/finish area.

Victory Ceremonies and Dinner:

The victory ceremonies and dinner will take place approximately 1,5 hours after the race finish at 5211 Friedburg, Stockschützenhalle, Salzburger Straße 9 (behind Gemeindeamt).

Equipment Check:

Before the race the handcycles and helmets can be checked by the technical delegate. Athletes using the wrong helmet colour in road races will not be allowed to start.













Toilets and Showers:

Wheelchair accessible toilets will be available at the race venue, at the Palfinger factory, at the Gemeindeamt Friedburg and at the Neue Mittelschule Friedburg.

You can take a shower at the Neue Mittelschule Friedberg (vis-à-vis Stockschützenhalle).

Wheelchair Accessible Accomodation

Within a 30km radius there are several hotels offering wheelchair accessible rooms. For information and reservation look at portal <u>booking.com</u> (offer e.g. for 2 persons/2 days)
